I was not a happy camper and kept telling myself I was NOT going to do them all over again. Sigh, I was not doing a very good job at talking myself into that, so I did them over.

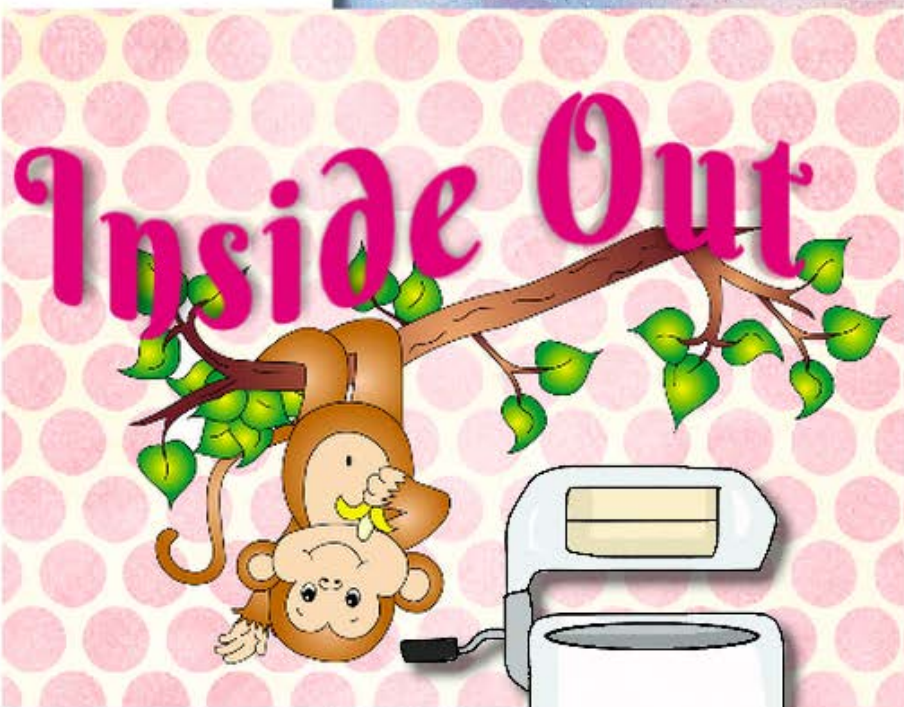
